Highlights

- 95% of parents share they are likely or very likely to recommend our school to other parents and families.
- Satisfaction of parent involvement in our school community has increased 11.1% by enhancing the opportunity for feedback and participation, including our School Council.
- 96% of parents believe our school community is a safe, caring, welcoming place for all students.
- Students and families feel they have access to a variety of supports and services in our school; 2.2% higher than the provincial average.

100% Parents believe they see evidence that their child learns about the Catholic faith in our school.

- 100% Parents believe that our school creates opportunities for students to encounter our faith through various experiences such as scripture reading, liturgies, sacraments, and celebrations.
- 99% Students believe that we all need to play a part in helping make our world a better place for everyone.
- 97% Students believe school encourages them to learn about their faith.

Targeted Areas

As a school community, we will focus on the implementation of the new curriculum in grades K-6. This will involve teacher collaboration and professional development to gain further insight into new learning objectives, high-yield instructional strategies, and meaningful student assessment.

As well, we will delve deeper into targeted literacy intervention for our K-3 students. This involves enhancing small group intervention with an emphasis on phonemic awareness and word study.

Future Priorities

- Students and staff will have the opportunity to celebrate the Eucharist as a family and enhance their connection to the church by attending mass more frequently as a community. Each week, one grade team will be attending mass at St. Stephen's (Lacombe) with the Parish.
- Students will actively spread kindness throughout our school community, living as Disciples of Christ. This will include the Kindness Squad's weekly mission sharing acts of kindness with others. We will celebrate student acts of kindness through BGR8 and Spartacus awards.
- Students will actively seeks authentic opportunities to serve and give back to their community, enhancing their appreciation for active citizenship.

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
